Science ALIVE! | Grades 2nd, 3rd (entering in fall)

June 11 - 15 | 9am - 4pm | Registration closes June 4 at 4pm

Powerhouse's Nature Discovery exhibit will be the inspiration for a week of exploring amazing life. From swimming microbes, to scaly reptiles, and majestic mammals, all forms of life have an important role in their ecosystems. Learn about what makes these creatures unique, and how they survive and thrive in our natural world. Campers will dissect animals, use microscopes to examine pond life, make scientific discoveries, and become young naturalists in training.

Whodunit? | Grades 4th, 5th, 6th (entering in fall)

June 18 - 22 | 9am - 4pm | Registration closes June 11 at 4pm

Solve a mystery using only science tools to investigate the crime scene! Camp detectives are introduced to crime scene investigation techniques including finger print analysis, spatter tests using simulated blood, chromatography, microscopes to study written documents, chemical analysis to identify unknown substances, and fabric flammability testing. Campers develop investigative questioning skills and perform experiments to crack the case.

Out-of-this-World Explorers | Grades 2nd, 3rd (entering in fall)

June 25 - 29 | 9am - 4pm | Registration closes June 18 at 4pm

Explore the Solar System and beyond with Powerhouse! From stars to comets, asteroids to planets, campers discover what can be found in the universe around us. Make a model comet, find constellations in the planetarium's simulated night sky, and see how the Sun compares to other stars in the galaxy. Then, experience a Challenger Learning Center program that's designed especially for summer science campers.

Adventures in Robotics | Grades 4th, 5th, 6th (entering in fall)

July 9 - 13 | 9am - 4pm | Registration closes July 2 at 4pm

Robots are used all around us in countless ways. Campers learn about different types of robots and the tasks they can perform. Exploring different robotic and programming concepts, campers use the design engineering process to construct and teach robots how to complete various challenges throughout the week.

Super Science Mash Up! | Grades K, 1st (entering in fall)

July 16 - 20 | 9am - 12pm or 1pm - 4pm | Registration closes July 9 at 4pm

Science discovery happens through fun projects for young scientists! Campers are introduced to different topics each day by trying simple experiments and creating science-based crafts. They'll become mini "experts" on all areas of science at Powerhouse after exploring our exhibits including Nature Discovery, Challenger Learning Center, Design Lab, and Forces: Earth and Space.

Interstellar Wonders | Grades 4th, 5th, 6th (entering in fall)

July 23 - 27 | 9am - 4pm | Registration closes July 16 at 4pm

Join Powerhouse as we explore the next steps in human space travel. Investigate destinations for interstellar journeys such as the Moon, Mars, and asteroids. Campers learn about what it takes to survive deep space travel and design their own spacecraft. Train to work as a team in preparation to fly two of their very own simulated missions to study a comet and investigate Mars in the Challenger Learning Center.
