



Position Title: Summer Camp Leaders – Camp Curiosity

Job Summary:

Do you like to learn, and share your enthusiasm for learning while working with children? Do you have a passion for science and technology? And are you keen to learn new skills and be part of the team preparing to open the new science center? The Museum of Science and Curiosity is seeking 14 Summer Camp Leaders to encourage children attending weeklong/daylong camps to have fun while they are actively learning about science, technology, engineering and math. Leaders are responsible for providing safe, friendly supervision directly to all children in their care, and indirectly to all children in the camp at any one time. This role contributes to the overall mission of MOSAC as a fun, active, and knowledgeable representative when communicating with both children and their parents/caregivers.

Skills & Talents:

- Experience working with children in informal learning or recreational environments
- Flexible, dynamic and active in learning, while being patient, empathetic and caring with children of various learning abilities
- Understanding of the role of play and inquiry in learning
- Good communication and team-work skills to contribute across the summer camp schedule
- Prompt, time-aware and able to supervise and organize groups of 12-24 children

Duties/Responsibilities:

- Lead groups of 12-24 children in daily priorities and activities through a complete week of learning programs
- Follow any related Pandemic Safety protocols, as trained by the MOSAC team following State and County health guidelines
- Stimulating children's curiosity and questioning, problem-solving and creativity, and active participation of all knowledge levels
- Learn the objectives of assigned camps and follow daily program schedules

- Adjust activities within program schedules to adapt to the immediate circumstances, e.g. weather, physical location, coordination with other Camp Leaders
- Supervising teen volunteers who support the camp groups

Education and Experience:

- High school diploma or equivalent
- Previous summer camp or recreation program experience an asset

Physical Requirements:

- May require standing and walking 75% of the time, lifting up to a maximum of 15 pounds, and other physical actions that include stooping, kneeling, bending, standing
- Work may involve outdoor activities in addition to programs within the facility
